Part 1 of Volume 61 (January- June) is scheduled to be published. Legal professionals, teachers, academicians and research scholars who are desirous of contributing research paper, case comment, book review etc., are requested to submit on any topic of sociolegal and legal importance.

A soft copy of the manuscript is to be submitted by email to *pulr@pu.ac.in*, along with submission of two hard copies addressed to the Chairperson, Department of Laws, Panjab University, and Chandigarh–160014. The last date of submission is 15 May 2022. To facilitate speedy processing of the manuscripts, authors are requested to strictly adhere to the guidelines of publication. Queries concerning the journal and submissions therein may be directed on the above given email.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Categories:
- (i) Research Paper/Article: Around 7000 words,
- (ii) Book Review: Around 2500 words,
- (iii) Case Comment: Around 3000 words.

The word limit is inclusive of footnotes.

- 2. Every manuscript must be labeled as: Research Paper/ Article, Case Comment or Book Review.
- 3. All manuscripts must be accompanied with:
- (i) A covering letter with the name(s) of the author(s), official designation, institution/affiliation, the title of manuscript and contact information (address, email, phone number, etc).
- (ii) A plagiarism report/ certificate from recognized similarity checking software viz. Urkund or Turnitin. Submissions with plagiarism content of more than 10% and copyright issues will not be accepted for publication.
- (iii) A certificate that the manuscript submitted is a piece of original work and has not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere.
- (iv) An abstract (not exceeding 250 words along with 5 keywords) describing the work and its significance.
- 4. The text of the manuscript submitted should be in MS word format, Times New Roman style, font size 12, with line spacing of 1.5, one-inch margin on all four sides and justified. All headings should have uniform formatting.
- 5. Footnotes should be in font size 10 and in Times New Roman style. Lengthy and multi-paragraph footnotes should be avoided. Do not add references and end notes at the end of the manuscript.
- 6. Text of the manuscript along with other inclusions must include the following:
- (i) Introduction,
- (ii) Evolution of subject matter,
- (iii) Analysis of socio-legal developments,
- (iv) Analysis of existing laws,
- (v) Relevance of subject matter in Indian context,
- (vi) Specific Conclusion and Suggestions thereto.
- 7. The manuscript may be on a legal issue or a social-legal issue. Manuscript devoid of any legal phenomenon or approach may be rejected out rightly.
- 8. We accept submissions from legal professionals, teachers, academicians, research scholars, members of the legal fraternity and other professionals. Research scholars, social workers and academicians from non-legal backgrounds can make submissions provided the manuscript submitted is strictly multidisciplinary (socio-legal) in approach.

- 9. Co-authorship is permissible up to 3 authors. Not more than one submission is accepted from an author whether writing individually or jointly.
- 10. We follow the blind peer review process; therefore, the author's name or affiliation or any other identifying information should be removed from the manuscript except near the title of the manuscript.
- 11. The Author is required to take note of:
- (i) originality of the theme,
- (ii) novelty of the subject,
- (iii) clarity of the idea,
- (iv) presentation of subject systematically and
- (v) linkage of conclusion with the contents.
- 12. All footnotes/ references should conform to the Bluebook (19th Edition) Citation Format.
- 13. Tables, if any should be numbered consecutively. The title of the table should appear above the table and sources at the bottom.
- 14. Only works that have not been published earlier or which are not being considered for publications elsewhere will be entertained.
- 15. Mere submission of contribution shall not confer any claim for publication. The editorial Board reserves all rights concerning the publication of the submissions and their decision shall be final. The Board's decision as regards the interpretation of guidelines or any other matter related to publication shall be final.
- 16. Once published, Copyright over the manuscript shall vest with Panjab University Law Review.
- 17. The manuscripts are to be submitted in soft as well as in hard copy. The written material in both the copies submitted should be same.
- 18. Soft copies of all submissions must be forwarded to *pulr@pu.ac.in* and two hard copy of the manuscript should be sent to the editor- Chairperson, Department of Laws, Panjab University, Sector 14, Chandigarh-160014.
- 19. In case, the submitted manuscript is not published in the journal, the author shall be intimated through e-mail and the author may send it for publication elsewhere. Manuscripts not accepted for publication will not be sent back to contributors.
- 20. Manuscript submitted after the due date and without adhering to the above instructions will not be considered for publication.
- 21. Contributors will be charged fee of Rs. 500/- for published copy of the journal.
