Financial Mathematics

Explore the main topics in financial mathematics and improve your mathematical understanding of the financial products used in the financial industries.

The course will cover applications of geometric series – annuities, sinking funds, mortgage and debt repayments, options – general properties, put/call parity, bounds on option prices, option pricing using the binomial model, the Cox-Ross-Rubinstein form, and the Black-Scholes formula for pricing derivatives.

The course is ideal for business students who want to improve their mathematical understanding, and mathematics students who are considering a career in Finance.
