The Group of Twenty (G20) is the premier forum for international economic cooperation. It plays an important role in shaping and strengthening global architecture and governance on all major international economic issues. The G20 Summit is held annually, under the leadership of a rotating Presidency. It brings together the world’s major advanced and emerging economies.

India holds the Presidency of the G20 from 1 December 2022 to 30 November 2023. The theme of India’s G20 Presidency - “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam” or “One Earth · One Family · One Future” - is drawn from the ancient Sanskrit text of the Maha Upanishad. Essentially, the theme affirms the value of all life – human, animal, plant, and microorganisms – and their interconnectedness on the planet Earth and in the wider universe. The theme also spotlights LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment), with its associated, environmentally sustainable and responsible choices, both at the level of individual lifestyles as well as national development, leading to globally transformative actions resulting in a cleaner, greener and bluer future.

For India, the G20 Presidency also marks the beginning of “Amritkaal”, the 25-year period beginning from the 75th anniversary of its independence on 15 August 2022, leading up to the centenary of its independence, towards a futuristic, prosperous, inclusive and developed society, distinguished by a human-centric approach at its core.

As our Hon’ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi ji said, “Our mindsets are shaped by our circumstances. Through all of history, humanity lived in scarcity. We fought for limited resources, because our survival depended

on denying them to others. Confrontation and competition -between ideas, ideologies and identities - became the norm.

India's G20 Presidency will work to promote this universal sense of one-ness. Hence our theme -

'One Earth, One Family, One Future'.

Rules-

1. Preference for a Portfolio/country can be mentioned in the registration form.
2. UNA USA Rules of Procedure will be followed for the proceedings of the committee.
3. Roll call- The Chair (judge/ executive board) will take the attendance before the sessions starts through roll call and the members have to give their attendance as “Present”.
4. General Speakers List- The GSL is the default format of committee which is the formal debate, where a country may only appear on the list once at any given time.

5. Moderated caucus- When the General Speakers List is open, a delegate may introduce a motion for a moderated caucus, which is a less formal debate format to debate a specific subset of the topic.

6. Unmoderated Caucus- When the General Speakers List is open, a delegate may introduce a motion for an unmoderated caucus, the least formal debate format. Delegates in this may move around the room and speak freely to one another to discuss and deliberate regarding their ideas and other issues.

7. Working Paper- They are intended to aid with the work of the Committee and present the viewpoints of the delegates and the potential solutions to the topic.
